

There were other murders. S.T.O.P. sent evidence to the Departments of Education & Labor that politically caught up persons like Sarah Goddard Power was murdered, for the reason that she would not go along with the Kellogg Foundation's plot to undermine our Nation through using Michigan Public Schools, in particular Michigan and Battle Creek Public Schools and using Universities, in particular Michigan Universities.

The Kellogg Foundation "picked up the tab" for the approximately 1000 plate dinners at the Battle Creek Stouffer Hotel, 9-29 and 30, 1992 sponsored by the Calhoun County Community Mental Health. City, County and State officials and the C.E.O.'s of the numerous non-profit organizations, such as the Mid Counties Employment & Training Consortium Inc. and Battle Creek Unlimited attended.

A special investigation should be initiated of Western Michigan University because of its illegal and corrupt surveys. The Kellogg Foundation funded the Survey "about the quality of life in Calhoun County" John Seita was the person to whom Kellogg furnished the money. Western Michigan University is John Seita's employer. John Seita recommended Bradford King for a position with the Calhoun County Mental Health Dept. Bradford King nor Diane King was making livable wage. Brad King was only working part time for Western Michigan University.

Both Brad King and Diane King were directly or indirectly affiliated with Western Michigan University. Western Michigan University was the survey floater for "the quality of life in Calhoun County" and paid \$5.00 to students and parents in Battle Creek to complete the survey. The information of that and other Kellogg Foundation Funded Surveys were used as Statistics of Need to HUD, Education, Labor, Health and other state and federal departments for state and federal funds. One in particular is THE COMPREHENSIVE HOUSING AFFORDABILITY STRATEGY (CHAS) prepared for the city of Battle Creek and presented to HUD.
