The money was promised from the Kellogg Foundation (a Grant). The production was going to be through Western Michigan University.

U.S. District Court, K90-CV-829 is a current Insurance Fraud Case filed against the Kellogg Foundation and the City of Battle Creek for the illegal use and possession of the L.W. Robinson Building. Despite of this fact, the city is continuing with an extension of Western Michigan University in the L.W. Robinson Building.

The renovation contractors working on the CCDC/DDA Robinson Building/Western Michigan University adds to the list of potential suspects who stood to gain more from getting rid of Diane King than her husband.
