The panel will be preceded by a film on the life of Mr. Kennedy and the panel discussion in front of an audience, will follow.


Bobby Kennedy Jr. will co-host the anniversary with me.


Please let me know if you can join us in the celebration to the life of a man who shared the vision of the American Indian.
