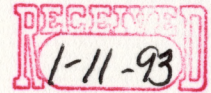

Dear Chief Mankiller:

I am extremely pleased that, at its recent meeting, the Board of Trustees voted to confer upon you the degree of Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*.

We very much hope that you can be present at Colby's 172nd Commencement Exercises on Sunday morning, May 23, 1993, when the degree will be conferred. The College will, of course, cover your travel expenses and will arrange hotel accommodations for you while you are in Waterville.
