Finally, after several weeks of efforts to write this letter, I am able to do it now.

Firstly, I am very happy to hear all is going well with you and happy, also, to hear that practically all the guests will be arriving on August 11. Kyle is buzzing!!

Secondly, but perhaps more importantly an item in this letter which is just as important is your willingness to help fund raise.

We are seeking at least \$10,000 or more for this event. The drum groups expenses are the largest amounts since both groups (White Fish Bay and Elk's Whistle Singers are both from Canada and must travel long distances with their families. We need \$6,500 for them plus \$1,000 for local singers.

We need, of course, more but approximately \$2,500 for preparation of grounds, electrical wiring and a good sound system will be sufficient.


