I have never written to a Chief before so I'm not sure of the proper form.

Jam sure of one thing though. We need your help. The miami Inibe of Opla. is buying some land that was originally Cherokee hand. We understand that they wast to put it in trust with the Bureau of Indian affairs and then build a prison there.

There in the rural community of Marcissa, where the proposed prison will be built strongly object to this project. We do not want to live across the road from a prison.

We feel there are other projects that can be placed there that will have a more positive benefit to the Community and the Tribe.

I am asking that you not permet the Manni Tribe of Oklahoma to take over
