I do hope you understand that I was not looking for a handout or a free ride. Just a little help to help get us back on our feet. Does the Nation ever make loans like a bank or a loan company would. If so how would a person obtain a loan and would the payments be? If not, why? Is everything handled through the BIA?

A second job is an option I am considering. My friend offered me a job working weekends, Friday and Saturday nights. This would mean I would not get to see my children much at all. She owns a night club and said all I would
