

They may take self-enrichment courses offered by the Chautauqua Institution, and are expected to take part in the Order's Christian Leadership Class.

The Order owns a Chapel with a Fellowship Hall and three houses which will accommodate 43 students and the staff.

The Order contributes to the American and Foreign Bible societies; the Leonard Wood Foundation for Leprosy Research; World Vision; St. Christopher's College in Madras, India; and missions in the Philippines, Hong Kong and Formosa.

WHO MAY BELONG?

"Anyone whose aims and purposes are in accord with its objects and who holds himself or herself responsible to The King, our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ" is eligible to join according to the By-laws.
