
I write to offer my services in two areas of activity which might be of interest to your people. I enclose assorted credentials and references.

The first area is that of experience in raising funds and teaching skills in sheltered workshops and in cottage industries. In addition to the experience noted in the enclosures, I helped set up a cottage industry in Campbell County, Tennessee 3 years ago in which we successfully produced and marketed rustic furniture from sawmill slabs.

The other area of experience is in art therapy as a prevention of drug and alcohol use and for after-care treatment. I have taught woodcarving to children's classes and adult classes at 3 colleges here, including the University of Houston. I serve in these two areas on a contingent fee of 2% of sales and 1% of funds raised or grants received for tools, buildings, operating capital, accounts receivable and inventory.
