## SECTION 4 <br> CHIEF

Subject to directives of the Council, the Chief shall exercise general supervision, direction, and control of the business and affairs of the association. The Chief shall preside at all meetings of the association and the Council. The Chief shall serve as an ex-officio member of all committees of the association.

## SECTION 5 SECOND CHIEF

In the absence or disability of the Chief, the Second Chief shall perform all the duties of the Chief, and in so acting shall have the powers of the Chief. The Second Chief shall have such other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed from time to time by the Council. The Second Chief shall appoint the nominating committee for the annual election of officers.

## SECTION 6

SCRIBE

The Scribe shall keep a full and complete record of all business meetings and shall discharge such other duties of the office as prescribed by the Council. The Scribe shall act as the authorized correspondent for the association.

## SECTION 7 TREASURER

The Treasurer shall receive and safely keep all funds of the association and deposit them in the bank or financial institution(s) designated by the Council. Those funds shall be disbursed only by checks of the association signed by the Chief or Second Chief and the Treasurer. The Treasurer shall have other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed from time to time by the Council.

## SECTION 8 <br> ELDER

The Elder shall be at least sixty (60) years of age, and shall serve as an advisor when called upon by the Chief, the Council, or the membership. The Elder, although not an elected officer, serves on the Council. The Elder shall be appointed or removed by the Chief.
