February 3, 1992- This is Monday exactly one week after Professor Hunter's speed memo and three weeks into the spring 92 semester. Professor Esparza writes a File Note regarding me. He begins it by writing, "On two other meetings you were not there nor did you leave a note. This is a serious problem and if not corrected, I will recommend that you be dismissed from the program". This File Note reads as if it were directly written to me. I had not seen this File Note until September 18, 1992. The "meetings" he refers to are two class days. These two class absences were total absences in that class for the whole semester. The two absences are referred to perpetually in the subsequent File Notes and memos from Professor Curcio and Dr. Sullivan regarding attendance. Professor Esparza mentions it again in his June 26, 1992 letter. Again the threat of "dismissal" is prevalent. Professor Esparza gives no specific dates of the "two other meetings". There is also a notation by Professor Curcio on this File Note stating, "Please keep me posted." I sense Professor Curcio's undue influence in that notation. Again, I wish to emphasize the duress I was under by being continually harassed by threats of dismissal like this. Professor Esparza's File Note of February 3 is misleading in its generality and harassing with the threat of dismissal. The contents of this misleading File Note is perpetuated in subsequent memos and letters on OUHSC letterhead to the point
