

I hold a Juris Doctor degree from Oklahoma City University School of Law. I ranked second in my class of forty at night while working full time in an executive capacity as a landman with Continental Oil Company. I was a member of the tenured faculty at Central State University in Edmond, Oklahoma, teaching law and real estate for ten years while serving as Senior Vice President of United Founders Life Insurance Company and while serving as Municipal Judge in Edmond, Oklahoma.
