The Seminole council which met here for the purpose of taking action against joint statehood, adjourned without undertaking any business. The council was called to meet by Chief John F. Brown, for the purpose of adopting a resolution protesting to Congress against admission to statehood with Oklahoma. When the council met it was discovered that both the chief and the second chief were absent and an adjournment was taken until such time as the chief might be present.
