NEWS ITEM OF J. F. BROWN

Governor Brown, of the Seminoles, returned to Washington this week after an absence of several days in the west. He and other members of the Seminole nation are working for a concurrence on the part of the house conferees in the Seminole agreement.

Those interested in the provision allowing innocent holders of Creek fraudulent warrants to sue the Creek nation in the court of claims are working on that line with those by whom the matter will finally be settled.

It will be remembered that the Indian Appropriation bill carries Senate amendments on these questions, in which the House will be asked to con-
cure through the Conference Committee.
