to law and evidence there shall be no appeal from their decission (sio).

- 61. And be it further enacted That it shall be the duty of this committee to be prompt in attention to every and all General Councils and in case of failure on the part of any member unless he has a lawful excuse shall forfeit one half of his Salary.
- 62. Be it enacted that each Principal Chief of Arkansas and Canadian District shall have full power to call District Council for the purpose of settling such Suits as may come up within their respective Districts.
- 63. And be it further enacted That all persons shall have the right of appeal from the decission(sic) of the District Council to the General Council.
- 64. Be it enacted That if two towns agree to play ball and it is afterward found out that either had taken in playmen from other Towns, they shall forfeit a fine of Fifty Dollars.
- 65. Be it enacted that in order more effectually to carry into effect the law prohibiting the introduction and vending of ardent Spirits, It shallbe the duty of the Light horse men of each District to execute the said law to its full extent to search find and spill all the spiritous(sic) liquors that may be found within our respective limits and to collect a fine at the rate of four Dollars per gallon for all the liquor so spilled.
- 66. And be it further enacted That if any citizen of this nation be found guilty of having violated the above law by
