- 85. Be it enacted that all strays shall be taken to the ensuing General Council and there exhibited and in all cases they shall be sold to the highest bidder within twelve months after they are taken on the stray list.
- 86. Be it further enacted That persons proving stray horses after they shall have been taken on stray rolls shall pay two Dollars per head which shall be equally divided between said Captain and the individual having them in charge.
- 87. Be it further enacted that when strays are sold one half of the proceeds of the sale shall be paid into the National Treasury and the other shall be divided as provided for above.
- 88. Be it further enacted it shall be the duty of any individual taking up stray cattle in their neighborhood and report the same to all with whom they may meet for the term of two years when they shall be taken to the District Council in which they are strayed and sold to the highest bidder, one half of the proceeds to be paid into the national Treasury and the other half to be paid over to the individual having them in charge.
- 89. Be it enacted that after cattle shall have been posted as strays proving them shall be required to pay one Dollar per head.
- 90. Be it enacted that it shall be unlawful for any stud to run at large over two years old and all such may be castrated at public gatherings.
