

115. No slave shall be found away from his or their master's premises without a pass during the hours of night and any negro or negros (sic) who shall be found guilty of the violation of the above Law shall receive twenty five lashes.

116. It shall be unlawful for any slave to have or carry wepons(sic) of any description and should any slave be found guilty of violating the above Law after the 1st day of March A. D. 1861 He or She shall receive twenty-five lashes.

117. It shall be the privilege of any citizen of this nation to inforce the foregoing laws.

118. In all cases where owners of slaves shall give them a pass they shall specify in the pass the point or points to where the slave may be going.

119. In all cases where the owner shall give a pass without specifying the point or points to which he or they designs negro or negros(sic) to go shall pay ten Dollars for every such offence.

120. From and after the passage of this Law it shall be unlawful for any slave to have his or their time from owners.

121. Any person or persons who shall violate this law shall be made to pay the sum of fifty Dollars for every such offence which shall be paid into the National Treasury of the Creek Nation.

122. It shall not be lawful for any slave to engage in any mercantile business, when the goods or chattels are his or theirs. They shall be taken and sold to the highest bidder, and all monies so realized shall be paid into the National
