An act entitled an act authorizing
the Superintendent of Public Schools
to transfer Fort Coffee to New Hope
Academy and for other purposes.

Section 1st. Be it enacted, by the General
Council of the Schoolmen's Union assembled,
that in the event Mr & Mrs George J. McComb
should die, after being duly notified
thereof, to give possession of Fort Coffee
to the Superintendent of Public Schools
within a reasonable time; the Superintendent
duty of Public Schools is hereby authorized
and required to apply to the County
Judge of Shelbyville County for a writ
of execution, which shall be executed
by the Sheriff of said County, and
shall make due return thereof to the
County Court on the day to which the
same is returnable; the Superintendent
of Public Schools shall then transfer
the said Fort Coffee to New Hope
Academy for the use and benefit
of said Academy whereof
