

An act granting Choctaw Children living in
the Chickasaw Nation, School Privileges

Sec 1st

Be it enacted by the General Council of the
Choctaw Nation as follows

That the Choctaw: living in the Chickasaw
Nation shall have the privilege of sending
one Scholar to the States, one Scholar
to Spencer Academy and one to New Hope
on the same terms as other Choctaw
Children

Be it further enacted That it shall be the
duty of the Superintendent of Schools to
make the selection from among the Children
living in the Chickasaw Nation as provided for
in the first section of this act, and that this
act take effect, from and after its passage
