

A Resolution providing expenses for Special Agents to Washington to attend to the case against the Railroad.

Be it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled, that the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money not otherwise appropriated to pay the necessary expenses of the Special Agent appointed by the Principal Chief to go to Washington and employ counsel to prosecute the claim of the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nations against the M. T. & F. Railway: provided however that said Special Agent shall make a detailed report of his expenses to the Principal Chief to be submitted to the next General Council, ~~and~~ the Auditor shall issue his warrant thereon accordingly under the direction of the Principal Chief, and the Treasurer shall pay the same, and this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
