

An act relating to the account of Peter Garland District Trustee for first District, C. N. whereas, the accounts of Peter Garland, District Trustee, first District, C. N. are in such confusion as to make it impossible properly to balance the same and:

Whereas, there appear to be outstanding unsatisfied certificates of said Peter Garland amounting to the sum of \$1281.25.

Now therefore, be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled:

1st That the District Attorney for said first District is hereby instructed to proceed at once by law against said Peter Garland & his sureties on his bond for the collection of said sum and all proper costs - and that the money so collected be turned into the National Treasury for National purposes -

2nd In order to make good the deficiency caused by said outstanding certificates and to pay the same, there is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$1281.25, and that the
