

An act in reference to Licensed
Traders.

Be it Enacted by the General
Council of the Choctaw Nation
Assembled

That Licensed Traders
shall pay annually the sum of
~~Three~~ ^{Five} hundred dollars for the
privilege of selling goods or
trading in the Choctaw Nation.
That this act shall apply to every
non-citizen who trades or exposes
goods for sale in any manner
and if a trader conducts a bus-
ness at more than one point
he shall pay the like sum of
~~three~~ ^{five} hundred dollars for every
and each such business
sect 2. That all acts or parts of
acts in conflict herewith are
repealed and this act take effect
and be in force from and
after the first day of January
