Be It Enacted by the General
Council of the Choctaw Nation
Assembled -

That Mrs Anna Boyd
Mrs Lewis Rutherland, Mrs
Ozie Travis, Mrs M. Williams
Choctaws lately from the State
of Mississippi - and full
Sisters of C. A. Bilbo who has
been heretofore admitted -
and their descendants be and
they are hereby declared
Citizens of the Choctaw Nation

Be It further Enacted that
this act take effect and be
in force from and after
its passage -
