Sec 1st Be it enacted by the  
General Council of the Cherokee  
Nation Assembled That an Election  
precinct is hereby Established at or  
near Gilbert Cooper place in Cedar  
County to be called and known  
hereafter as Lick precinct;

Sec 2nd Be it further enacted  
that the first Election held at  
said Lick precinct shall be  
on the first Wednesday in August  
1892. and thereafter and that this  
act shall take effect and be  
in force from

and after its passage.
