

An act in relation to District-judges

See I

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Lebockaw nation assented to that no District judge of this nation shall practice law in any court in his District while in office or counsel and/or advise in such suit that may be pending in any of the courts District or County in his District during his term of office.

See II

Be it further enacted that any judge guilty of violating the above section shall be declared guilty of a misdemeanor in office and removed from office as the law in such cases prescribes and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
