

An act Making appropriation
for students in the States -

Be It Enacted by the General
Council of the Choctaw Nation
Assembled,

Section 1 That the sum of Twelve thousand
five hundred dollars is hereby
appropriated to defray the ex-
penses of forty students atten-
ding school in the States - Twenty
Boys ^{and} Twenty Girls - to be ex-
pended in proportion of Three
hundred dollars each for Boys
and Three hundred and Twenty
five dollars for each girl -

Section 2 That this act take effect and
be in force from and after
its passage
