departed this life on the 16th day of
December 1891 And while we bow

well. Yet with sad hearts we mourn
the loss of one who so long served his
people faithfully, and vacated the
office of Principal Chief of the Choctaw
Nation with honor and always had
the interest of his people at heart therefore
Be it resolved by the General Council of the
Choctaw Nation assembled That both
houses of the General Council adjourn
until Tuesday morning at 9 o'clock

A. M. the 18th day of Oct 1892 out of respect
of the deceased B. J. Smallwood
and that each member wear the usual
badge of mourning for thirty days.
