Your committee to whom was referred the petition of J. J. Gordon, asking for appropriation to ~~enable~~<sup>enable</sup> to defend the rights of jurisdiction of the Choctaw Nation in his case pending before the United States Court at Paris Tex and the same under consideration and reports the following act and asks its passage.

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled,

That the sum of five hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of any money in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated to enable J. J. Gordon to employ attorney to defend his case pending in the United States Court at Paris Tex on the certificate of the principal chief the Auditor shall issue his warrant for the amount,

Be it further enacted, That this act take effect and be in force after its passage
