

Be it Enacted by The General Council
of The Choctaw Nation Assembled,

That The privilege is hereby -
granted to Charles Siflore - a cit-
-izen of Atoka County Choctaw-
Nation to continue a toll bridge
over Limestone Creek - a branch
of Little Boggy - at Limestone Gap
in Atoka County Choctaw Nation
and the said Charles Siflore
shall keep and maintain a
strong and safe bridge over
said stream, and he shall
be entitled to demand and to
receive from all persons cross-
-ing on same - except citizens
of the Nation - The following rates
- to wit - For each four wheeled
wagon or vehicle The sum of
fifty - cents if drawn by four
or more horses - mules or oxen &
if drawn by one or two horses -
mules or oxen twenty five cents - For a
man & horse ten cents - For each
animal if in drove of Cattle -
