

An Act providing for certain  
Improvement at Jones Academy.

Be it enacted by the General  
Council of the Choctaw Nation  
assembled: That the sum of  
seven thousand dollars (\$7000<sup>00</sup>)  
be and the same is hereby  
appropriated out of any money  
in the National Treasury to  
make improvements and addi-  
tions to Jones Academy buildings.

That said sum shall be  
subject to the contrall of the  
Board of Education and that  
said improvements and addi-  
tions shall be made under  
the supervision of said Board.

And the Auditor shall issue  
his warrant for the same  
and the Treasurer shall  
pay it. This act to take  
effect and be in force  
from and after its passage.
