

An Act for the relief of William Frazier-

Sec 1

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled- That the National Auditor is hereby directed to issue his warrant and the treasurer pay the same in favor of William Frazier to reimburse him for money expended in a doctor's bill caused from a wound received by him while assisting Nelson Herkin's for now District Light horseman of the 3rd District in arresting a whiskey peddler- That the said warrant shall be for thirty five dollars and shall be in full of all demands of William Frazier on this behalf- And this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage-
