

BILL NO 28

AN ACT CHANGING THE COUNTY COURT GROUND IN KIAMICHIA COUNTY, CHOCTAW
NATION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION, IN
EXTRAORDINARY SESSION ASSEMBLED.

Section 1 That the County Court ground in Kiamichia
County be and the same is hereby changed and removed from its pres-
ent site at Goodland, Choctaw Nation, to Hugo, Choctaw Nation, about
three miles south and the County Judge shall select a suitable
and convenient house in said town for the place of Holding Court,
and the said Court Ground shall be known, in future, as Hugo Court
Ground, and the first term of County Court shall be held in said
Court Ground the first Monday in February, 1903, and all terms of
said court thereafter; and all acts coming in conflict with this
act are hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect and be in
force from and after its passage and approval.

An act changing the County Court ground
in Kiamochia County Choctaw Nation.

Be it enacted by the General Council
of the Choctaw Nation in extraordinary
Session assembled:

Sec 1 That the County Court ground
in Kiamochia County be and the
same is hereby changed and removed
from its present site at Goodland
Choctaw Nation to Hugo Choctaw Nation
about three miles south. And the County
Judge shall select a suitable and
convenient House in said town
for the place of holding Court. And
the said Court ground shall be known
in future as Hugo Court ground.
And the first term of County
Court shall be holden at said
Court ground the first Mon-
day in February ¹⁹⁰³ And all
terms of said Court thereafter
And all acts coming in conflict
with this act are hereby repealed
and this act shall take effect and
be in force from and after its
passage & approval *Left Fulton*
