Referring to the Resolution of the National Council of the Choctaw Nation, approved by the Principal Chief November 24, 1905, asking that the land offices at Atoka and Ardmore, when consolidated, be located at Coalgate, Indian Territory, you are advised that such Resolution was considered by the Department December 20, 1905, and it was held that such Resolution did not require Executive action, but the matter being one under the immediate supervision of the Commissioner to the Five Civilized Tribes, a copy of the report of the Indian Office in reference to the matter has been furnished the Commissioner to the Five Civilized Tribes.
