

## Bill No 48

An Act Amendatory to an act, entitled  
an act relating to the school system of  
the Choctaw Nation

Be it Enacted by the General Council  
of the Choctaw Nation assembled:

That the act entitled an act relating to  
the school system of the Choctaw Nation  
approved October 30<sup>th</sup> 1890 be and the  
same is hereby amended so as to repeal  
all that portion and those provisions  
of said act which create and establish  
the office of school Trustee for the  
several districts of the Choctaw Nation and  
the office of District School Trustee is  
hereby abolished,

Sec 2, Be it further Enacted that the Superinten-  
dent of Public Schools shall hereafter,  
exercise under the direction and super-  
vision of the Principal Chief the duties of  
several District trustees and jointly  
with the Principal Chief the functions of  
the board of education as established and  
prescribed by said act of October 30<sup>th</sup> 1890  
to be done on the part of the District trustees  
of the Board of Education necessary  
for the successful operation of our schools  
are hereby abrogated or curtailed, but the  
same may be performed by the  
Superintendent of Schools under the  
supervision of the Principal Chief as herein before  
provided.

Sec 3<sup>rd</sup> Be it further enacted that this act shall  
be in force from and after its passage and  
approval. Proposed by, Rott Benton.
