

An Act Changing The Election precinct in
Gaines County - Choctaw Nation.

Be it enacted by the General Council of
the Choctaw Nation assembled.

Sec. 1. That The Election precinct heretofore known
and called Leflore precinct in Gaines County
is hereby changed and removed to Featherstone
in said County, about two miles east of
the present Leflore Election precinct: and
to be known and called Featherstone Election
precinct in said Gaines County, Choctaw
Nation.

Sec. 2. And that the first Election shall be held
at said Featherstone precinct on the first
Wednesday in August, 1902, and thereafter.

Sec. 3. Be it further enacted, that all acts or parts
of acts, coming in conflict with this act, are
hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect
from and after its passage.

An Act appropriating money to pay the
expense of the Special Election on the
Supplementary.

Be it enacted by the General Council of
The Choctaw Nation in regular session assembled.

Sec. 1. That the sum of Five Hundred and Ten
dollars (\$510⁰⁰) or so much thereof as
may be necessary be and the same is hereby
appropriated out of any money in the Nat-
ional Treasury not otherwise appropriated
to pay the expense of the Special Election
held September 25th 1902 on the Supplementary
Agreement.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted that all acts or
parts of acts coming in conflict with
this act is hereby repealed. And this act
shall take effect and be in force
from and after its passage.
