An Act Changing an Election precinct in Sans Bois County,

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation in regular session assembled:

Sec. 1. That the Election precinct in Sans Bois County heretofore known as Okchanah Chito precinct be and the same is hereby abolished.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted that an Election precinct be and the same is hereby established at Kinta in Sans Bois County and shall be known as Kinta precinct and that the voters of said County may vote at same at the next regular Election to be held on the first Wednesday in August 1902, and at every Election in said County thereafter, and that this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

That the Chairman of the Finance Committee shall appoint a clerk for the said Committee whose duty it shall be to make and keep a full record of the work of said Committee.

Be it further resolved, That the clerk of the said Finance Committee shall receive for his services Five dollars (\$5.00) per day. That the National Auditor shall issue his warrant for actual services, and the Treasurer shall pay the same. And this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

A resolution authorizing the Chairman of the Finance Committee to appoint an assistant clerk.

Be it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled:

Sec. 1. That the Chairman of the Finance Committee is hereby authorized and directed to appoint an assistant clerk.
