Resolution.

Accepting the report of Henry L. Sanguin, District Collector for the Third District of the Choctaw Nation, covering four quarters beginning the 1st day of July, 1903 and ending the 30 day June, 1904.

Your Committee to whom was referred the report of Henry L. Sanguin District Collector for the Third District of the Choctaw Nation, have carefully examined the same and find that it covers the four quarters beginning the first day of July, 1903, and ending the 30th day of June, 1904. Our examination shows the total amount collected to be three thousand four hundred and ninety seven dollars and thirty four cents (\$3497³⁴), less ten per cent (10%) three hundred and forty nine dollars and seventy three cents (\$344⁷³), due the Nation three thousand one hundred and forty seven dollars and sixty one cents (\$3147⁶¹); receipts from the National Treasurer, and Warrant handed in to the Committee shows that this amount has been paid into the National Treasury;

Therefore, we your Committee recommend the adoption of the following resolution

Be it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled:-

That, the report of Henry L. Sanguin, District Collector for the Third District be, and the same is hereby, accepted as true and correct; and that this resolution shall have effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval
