

Bill No 14.
An act
Empowering the District Judge to select
and empanel Jurors.

Be it enacted by the General Council
of the Choctaw Nation Assembled.

Sec I That the District Judge of the Choctaw
Nation be hereby Authorized and
empowered to select Jurors for their
respective Courts where County
Judge have failed to comply with
the law in this respect.

Sec II That the said Judge shall have such
discretionary powers in the final
disposition of the business pending
in their respective Courts as will
enable them to clear the dockets.

Sec III That all laws in conflict herewith
are hereby repealed and this
act shall take effect and be in
force from and after its
passage and approval.
