And then the Fox Clan, which is the most prominent clan that we have that still carries on big over there, is, and I--their attendants are the Wolf Clan who is--the head man I think is Henry Scott. And he's--when he knows it, why then everybody else falls in right behind him. They have even boys and girls. Same way with us. We alternate--we attendants for the Chief Clan and we come forth for the Chief Clan and visa versa, and things like that. And then the others, then as they go down the line, because there are not very many clans now. But lately, we've been all having to help each other, because we all have to because there is not enough attendants to carry on. So that's like I said, we're kinda at the end of our rope--we all have to help each other.

(How often do you have adoption ceremonies?)

Well, we usually have them after a person has passed on. We try to--we usually have them in the spring when everything is green--everything is coming back to life. And this here person that's buried is coming back to life, in this person that we have chosen to take this loved ones place. That's the reason why they have it in the spring. And then some of them have it in the fall, before the leaves begins to get--you know, too brown because they all change in the fall. But the best time is to have it in the spring. Everybody feels good in the spring. So, that's usually the--but every member
