of theirs are—is over at Ed's. Then north, around Cushing, they have it at Della Rubins, which is the Chief Clan. And so they have it there. And they also have it at their homes. It just depends on how a person wants to do. Of course they have a large place up there and she's already fixed for it—for things like that, so they use her place. It don't cost anything, it's just one of the things that are required. It's special for Indians to have these things. And that is the way with Ed Mack... Of course there's a lot of work over at Ed's because he's not prepared. They get prepared, but it's been pretty hard for Ed because he's getting old and he can't swing those poles or tents around like he could. (laughter) I know it's been pretty hard for him to.

(Who's in charge of making the arrangements? Is it the oldest person in the family or--?)

Yes. Un-huh. Usually the oldest person in the family. But they're getting away from that if they are--I think the family--the oldest one in this family that has lost their loved one is the one that takes over. Usually the--used to years ago, the elders of the clan took over then. But this way, that's what I say, we're all mixed up. We don't do according to the pattern that we have set before us, but we do the best we can. And sometimes there's other families that somebody might feel sorry for this family that couldn't go ahead and give the adoption for their loved ones and they'll pitch in and help thin family to carry this on because it's something special that should be done within four years anyway. And so they will chip in and help each other to get it over with. Of-course they say over in the Happy Hunting Ground, your folks are waiting for you to come--they watch this person that comes in from the East.
