of Comanche medicine men which I never saw and didn't hear of, but that was what somebody told me about this man whose name was Quin ni, Quin ni, Wish e Quin ni, that means "Grey Eagle". And he lived for a long time, but I have never seen this medicine man. But I saw the man that he worked on. (Aunt Sarah, was Grey Eagle the man he worked on?)

No, the man was Grey Eagle.

(The medicine man.)

The doctor--the medicine man. But the man he worked was--let's see what was his name. Jus lia se wah.

(What does that mean? )

That means "Thinking of going on the Warpath.
