Vernon: Yeah I know some of 'em at least it does. But he can trade that for other articles of furniture he's gonna need for this new house or something like that. And he better off than holding the tank. The uh. but when you say butane there uh. we're far enough north that butane is. so we use propane.

At that.

Mr. Clement: I was raised in south Texas boys where it don't ever get cold and we had butane. It's just the terminology. Where propane we'll be using in the country.

Vernon: And of course in you propane as much as butane why your butane tank
has to stand what is it, a hundred fifty. Two hundred pounds of pressure?

And your propane has to be certified (not clear)

Mr. Clement: And you see here is the thing you could get yourself into. Uha. with payments being based on income. Okay, I move in my range and my refrigerator and my butane tank, and I look up and I ve got a pretty fair job. And Joe Brow right down the road here, he didn't and all he came in was with his, the seat of his britches and his hat and his payments are less than mine. Now how come. See what I mean. And this is why I say, "let's make these all authority material."

(Several people talking.)

(Participant, man:) Yes, they're going to furnish a brand new refrigerator in this house.

Mr. Clement: And in all probability their payments on that refrigerator, well some of them will be just about as much as their rent because I think minimum rent on this is about \$8 dollars a month. (not clear) of their income. And if you get this thing too complex you have so many because after all your payments are based on what they earn.

(Background conversation --- several sentences)

Mr. Clement: Now here again you're solving a need and granted we'd like to see you all move into fine furniture but you don't have to sleep on the floor.
