He went to the mission. -

(Do you recall the name of it?)

Just the Kaws.

(Kaw Mission or ?)

Wh-hum. It wasn't named like Wheeler Mission or something like that. You know that Wheeler Mission is down in the southeast. Well, uh--Jim's uncle's daughter went to the mission down there at Konawa. Used to be the Sacred Heart Mission. And a bunch of the girls went down there from Kaw. And one of them took the rheumatism so bad she couldn't move. So she had to come home. (Didn't most of the kids to go some kind of school?)

Uh-huh.

(Just that one at Kaw or did they send them out to other places too?)
Well you've heard of this Carlisle School, haven't you?

(Yeah, back in Pennsylvania.)

Well, Jim had a cousin, he's not living now but his son is. He went to Carlicle, took his education from there. So did Jim Thorpe. You know who Jim Thorpe is.

(Yeah. Did Jim ever go to any type of school?)
