(Did you know his name?)

No.

(Did Edna and this Cheyenne -- do they have any children?)

Yeah. They got a daughter by the name of Maureen, and another girl, Linda.

And they got a boy, Charles. That's all.

(Where do they live?)

She lives in Watonga, but her youngest daughter lives in California and this other one was in Germany with her white man. And I don't know nothing about their kids. I hardly see them.

(Now Sitting Bull is one of your grandfathers--is that right?)
Yeah.

(Then his children, like Lydia and Moses, you you --?)

Lydia was supposed to be my aunt, but in Indian, it's "mother." But she's my aunt. And then Moses and all these are my uncles.

(But in Indian, would you call her the same as your mother?)

Yeah.

(And how about Moses and Joe Sitting Bull, would you call them the same as --?)
"Uncle." "Uncle." Yeah.
