Old blue clay. That's how they find 'em back in the, you know, where --(Yeah.)

-- clay blue over here in Arkansas, you know, where they --(Yeah.) ****

Where -- that's -- what we found in that mine, old blue clay. This old fella, he, you know, he finds anything. Well, he wouldn't tell me. (No.)

(too low) white man tell me, he was working with some Indian boy--down here somewhere. This boy (too low) -- Anyway she died when -- was telling us about that -- That's the last I heard. He told me his name. I forgot it. (Not clear) to go hunting. He's going to go hunting tomorrow. See if he can find some deer, rake up something up there in that brush. (not clear) knocking at the door. He went and got that -- some flint. (Sentence not clear.)
