

(This is the afternoon program of the Tia Pia Society, and they will have some Gourd dances and later on the Blackfeet Society will dance.)

Kaubin: We have missionary with us who has spent time in the States of Florida, Tennessee and Arkansas. Young, Indian gentleman which are Vietnam war veteran. We are acquainted with Nibs family (not clear). We are going to ask him at this time to give invocation for starting song for dances this afternoon. We have a guest with us, a young man who is spending time here with us taking pictures of Indian celebration. He will take back east with him as a part of this place--

INVOCATION BY TIM NIBS: (Invocation for about 2 minutes of tape.)

(Music and much background noise for about 15 minutes of tape.)

Kaubin: We have bleachers that are available for all you non-Indian visitors.

(More music for about 10 minutes.)

Kaubin: Why the purpose of the bugle. Original bugle captured, United States Army at the museum here at Ft. Sill, the symbol of Kiowa victory in certain battle with Kit Carson. Bugle was captured. Number of occasions in the past years, the original bugle has been used by the Kiowas. Bugle was captured by the Tia Pia Society and this ladies and gentlemen are the descendants of warriors, of the Indian war days. The United States Army would have the bugle in their possession today. (Music for about 5 minutes.)

Kaubin: To-morrow, War Trumpet will be brought in to arena. A very special-- we are going to have a dance coming up. Uncle Jim Auchiah. This place in the center of the arena is symbolic of the leadership of the Tia Pia Warrior Society. These are spears--spears or feather lances were used during the war days of the Tia Pia Society. They stand for a symbol of honor, respect and leadership of the Kiowa Tia Pia Society. An organization has been in existence for many many years. At this time the society as the tradition and custom of the order is to initiate members from time to time. A special has been announced for the purpose of initiating a new member who has proven himself qualified
