Yeah, that's what they ought to be callin' you since the first time you were beginning something down here. My name's just like the chicken.

(Laughter)

(0h, that's funny.)

(Sakey speaking in Cherokee)

She said they supposed to fix up this house you know, agent.

(Is it the Bureau ofIndian Affairs or the tribal government?)

(Maggie converses in Cherokee with Sakey) Well, it used to be in

Muskogee:--)

(Oh, it's the Bureau---)

Uh-huh (child making noise in background)

(Uh-huh. And does it have a bathroom?)

Huh-uh, she ain t got no water in the house.

(So that way she can get water in the bathroom. That'll be good Sakey.)

They're supposed to, they said. She said they'll paint it a little

bit. Oh—(speaks in Cherokee). It was black, I never did know that it

was paint over.

(I knew they d painted it.)

She said it gonna be blue house, so when they're finished they're gonna put another blue on top..

(Sakey, if I'm down at the Bureau, I'll ask them--I'll remind them.)
Haggiespeaks in Cherokee.

(I'll ask themwhat happened.)

(Sakey speaking in Cherokee.)

Uh huh. She said it have to go to Muskogee. That's what they told her.

(I'll ask themwhat happened. And when are they gonna be here.)

She said have to go way down to rest room. Nights, she said she's scared, you know. (speaking in Cherokee.) She said she gonna try to
