(All right)

Half way then south there just a little bit. Now right in there somewhere. It's not a very big stone.

(Yeah)

Stone sets up about that high. It's got Captain Falleaf on it.

(All right)

It says Captain Falleaf.

(I know where that one is then. What was his name? I mean full name?)

Grandpa. That's all I ever knowed of.

(Just Captain.)

That's all ever I knowed.
