Yeah. The Tiger. And the Beavers are all more or less the same bunch of people. They all get together and work with each other and help one another. It's just like a brother and brother. And there, there's your Bird, there's your Wind, anything within fowl and air. They combine. Anything on four foot, long tail or big tail,, they combine. Anything with horns and things that drags or something like that, they combine. These are your clans. You just more or less are named. Within the council ring, I am a Beaver. But actually on the outside clan I'm a Tiger. But the clan name within the Council ring is what you go by, but actually the Tiger is the clan that I am. And I belong to a tribal town called Okfuskee. And everyone belongs to a certain tribal town. And it is the way to explain that, I guess more or less, is down there it's sharp. Now that's about the best I could explain it. But lot of these, it is free to talk about. And lot of them it isn't. We have our own beliefs and lot of the younger generation calls it superstition. Which we hold to ourselves, highly with deep respect and pride, that we try to keep it alive as much as possible. And it's an enjoyable thing if you'd like to be an Indian that's living the life of an Indian. You might as well be all Indian. But I've no regrets. I've enjoyed every minute of it.
