There's about 46 camps here (at Rodeo grounds at Clinton). This is the 10th year for this pow-wow. Last year it cost over \$1,000.00. Money is raised throughout the year by benefit dances about once a month, and bingos. Also, people pledge beef, etc. It's inter-tribal, though most members are Cheyennes.

The Military Service Club is a new organization of war mothers. It started about a year or two ago and members are the younger mothers. Sophie is a member of the War Mother's Club that started in World War I and has continued.
